Whole School Topic: To Infinity and Beyond

What's been going on

This half term, our lessons have been based around our space topic, To Infinity and Beyond.

In English, we have been listening to and learning space songs. We have been really impressed with the number of facts the boys have been able to recall from memory about the Sun, Moon and the eight planets! We have also read several space themed stories (Back to Earth with a Bump & The Dinosaur that Pooped a Planet) and identified, labelled and ordered the planets. The boys have been working very hard on their sentence writing and handwriting, finishing sentences using their knowledge of space and even writing their own descriptive sentences about the some of the planets!

In maths, Pembroke Class have mainly been looking at properties of shapes. They started off by matching and naming 2D shapes and then moved on to investigating 3D shapes by rolling and sliding them. It is great to see the class becoming a lot more aware of the shapes around them.

In cooking, we have made cinnamon whirls, space themed cookies and pancakes. The focus has been on listening carefully to instructions, matching ingredients with their labels, tasting new things and discussing the temperature and properties of ingredients.
