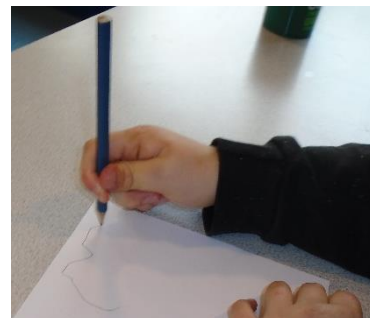
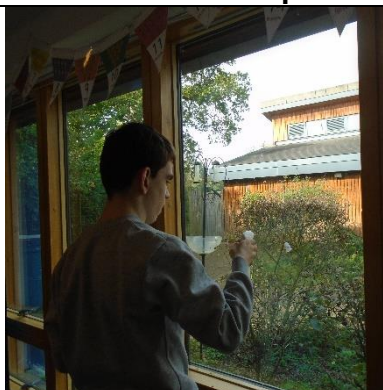
What we have been learning
