In literacy the children have learnt about the history of written Chinese characters and have enjoyed copying these characters onto lolly pop sticks to create a Mandarin scroll books.

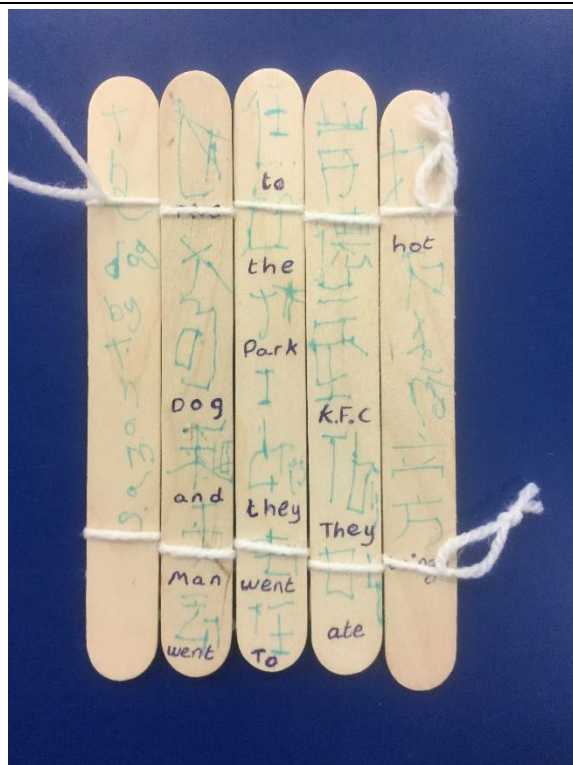
They have also created an in-depth study on a famous poet and have looked specifically at Shakespeare's play script called 'Twelfth Night'.
