What we have been learning:

Wow! Another fun filled half term in Caernarfon class! In English this half term we have focussed heavily on Speaking and Listening. We have ranged from debate to making telephone conversations and having appropriate conversation in different social situations. We were also involved with The Watermill Theatre where we undertook a media project to create reviews based upon different comedy mediums.

In Maths, we have continued to focus on number by exploring different methods of multiplication and division. We have also explored squaring and cubing numbers which have then been applied within a functional context. Caernarfon's maths class have explored Geometry, looking at angles and measurement as well as volume.

London Irish Rugby Club have continued to offer and deliver exciting and challenging experience for our students. There was a very successful trip to Madjeski Stadium as part of our World of Work sessions where students identified a plethora of roles that take place there. Rugby sessions have continued to expose our students to new skills which has built their resilience and sporting potential.

World of Work has focussed on stereotypes and attitudes that are favoured within a work setting.

Our class book has further developed our student's higher level thinking and expansion of ideas through everyday life situations and reactions of others.

Duke of Edinburgh volunteering has continued to be a success with students working well in a variety of different settings including charity shops and the Farm.

Caernarfon have undertaken the role of cooking for the whole unit and they have positively adapted to the influx of orders, conveying that they can continue to deliver high standards of food preparation under time constraints.

Students have thrown themselves into work experience placements allowing for development of work based skills and providing options for their future, with regard to the type of work they may be interested in.
