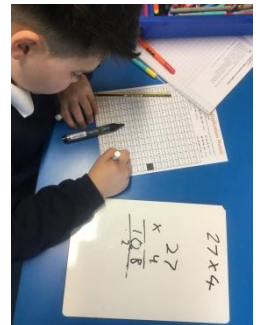
In English we have been learning to write a recount. As a class, we wrote a recount about the journey of an evacuee during the Second World War.
