This term in English we have been trying lots of different foods. The children have been encouraged to say yes or no when asked the question "do you like?". In maths we have been learning all about size and shape. The children used the words: big, small, long, short, heavy and light to describe objects. The children then looked at lots of different shapes, they named them, counted sides and corners and made pictures out of them.

The children have also been doing really well during their horse riding lessons. Lots of the children have never ridden a horse before and they are already gaining in confidence in either being around the horses or sitting on them. Some of the children are learning how to say "walk on" to get the horse going, "woah" to stop the horse and using the reins to steer.
