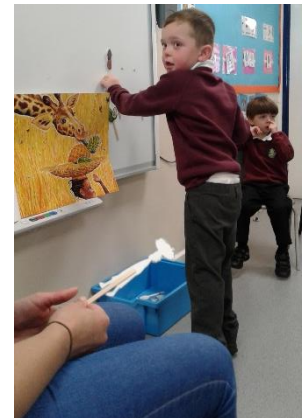
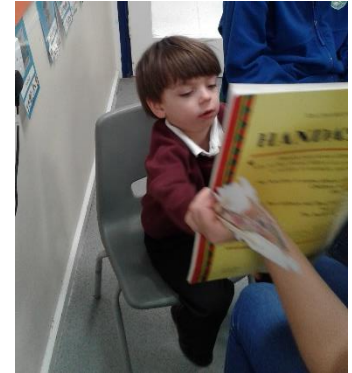
Cardiff class have very quickly settled into the school routine. They have formed good friendships with each other and are able to seek out an adult for support.
