We have worked on our English skills through 'We All Go Travelling By', making our own versions of the story and 'The Billy Goats Gruff'.

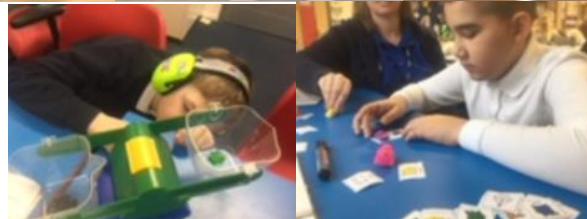
In Maths we have been focussing on Measurement – working on time and weight, as well as keeping ticking over with our number skills.
