What we have been learning:

Science - We have been learning about different environments, wildlife and plants. We have visited two different environments, Thatcham Lakes and Donnington Park. We braved the wet weather to go to Thatcham lakes and despite the rain we saw lots of different birds including a grebe, swallows and tufted ducks. Whilst at Donnington Park we learnt how to recognise different types of trees from their leaves.
