What we have been learning:

In English we have been looking at the book 'Superworm' then creating our own stories using different insects. In maths we have been looking at different ways to measure including time, length and weight. The pupils have enjoyed having the chicks come to visit the class where they were able to hold and pet them. We then discussed the life of a chick and looked at some other animals finding out where they live and learning about food chains. We have begun to look at categorising animals according to physical features and habitats etc for example, mammals, amphibians.

In our P.E lessons we have been having a go at field events, learning how to throw the vortex and the hammer. In drama we have been focusing on peer massage with call and response and have also progressed this to acting out a bird poem. In cooking we have continued to focus on healthy eating, where the pupils have been choosing healthy recipes they would like to make.

We ended this half term by having three great activity days with the whole of KS3. These included Youlbury on Tuesday, where the pupils had the chance to participate in archery and abseiling. Wednesday we went bowling and had lunch. Thursday we enjoyed team games at Snelsmore common and had a lovely picnic.
