They read and followed signs, studied animal footprints and dug up some soil to take a closer look at some worms! Next half term, we hope to visit again to do some more exploring!

This half term, they have played the African drums and blown raspberries (as you'd expect, they had no problem doing this!) to successfully produce a sound on the trombone. They also listened to different styles of music and discussed how it made them feel.
