Whole School Topic: The Living Rainforest

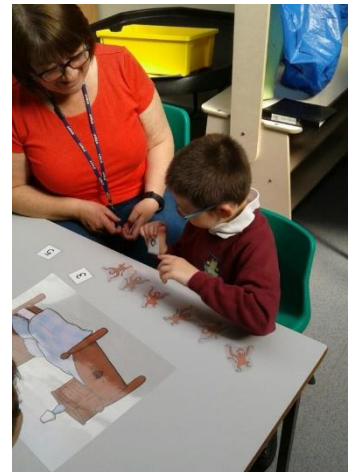
What we have been learning

This term in English we have introduced our new whole school topic 'The Living Rainforest'. We have been learning all about the different types of animals that live in the rainforest and making lots of different animal noises. We have been using 'I see...' to make sentences about the different animals we can see and trying to add in a describing word. For example 'I see frog' or 'I see a green frog'. The children have enjoyed seeing all the new animals and listening to their sounds.

In maths we have been focusing on number. The children have been practicing responding to the adult asking 'how many?', then touching each object or picture once and saying a number as they do. They then had to remember the final number they count to and find the matching numeral. We have also begun to move on to adding and taking away a number of objects from a set.

Life lessons this term has been all about healthy eating. We began by talking about food we like and dislike. Then moved on to food that is healthy and unhealthy and talking about which foods we should eat a lot of, which we should eat some of and which we should eat a little of. We have also done food tasting to say which fruits and vegetables they like and dislike.
