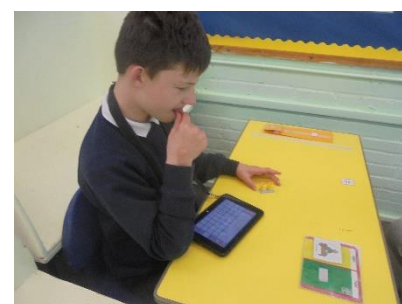
Some of our Maths, English and Art work has involved jungle/exotic animals. In inclusion on Friday afternoons we are looking at different animal prints and trying to recreate them.
