
In maths, we have been looking at addition and subtraction. The class are becoming more familiar with these terms and are a lot more confident with using objects to help them complete number sentences involving these operations.

Please always remember that if you ever have any worries or concerns, please either write in your child's diary or speak to a member of the team. Things can often be resolved or put at rest far quicker.


