Christian: You can now form all of the letters of the alphabet correctly and in the right order too. We are so impressed!

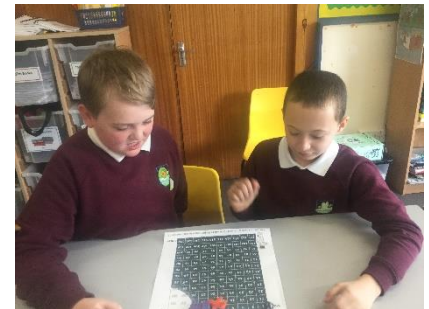
Connor: Well done for getting your resources together for each lesson, without an adult helping you. You are now so independent!
