What we have been learning this term:

It's been a short but busy term!

In Maths, we have been focusing on statistics. We have been collecting data in tally charts and using our data to draw tables and graphs.

In English, we have been reading 'Ted Rules the World' by Frank Cottrell Boyce. The book has brought up lots of issues for us to discuss and write about including longer weekends, global warming and food miles. To understand more about food miles we went to Waitrose to find out which countries some of the fruit and vegetables came from. We inputted our data into a spreadsheet and used it to create a pie chart to analyse our findings. Out of the 32 pieces of fruit and veg we looked at, only 6 of them were arown in the UK. We discussed the pros and cons of this and how different our food choices would be if we could only eat food that was grown in the UK. Emily also treated us to some fruit that we hadn't tried before- cherries, passion fruit, papaya and coconut.

In art, with Renée, we have been drawing parts of the face. We have created some fantastic pencil drawings that we are really proud of.

During our Food Wise lessons, with Sue, we have been focussing on heathy eating. We have made salsa, wraps and stir fry.

We have had some fantastic music lessons with Charles. We have been looking at different genres of music and we have been learning to play the basics on the guitar.

Louisa, the World of Work coordinator, came to talk to us about possible future employment opportunities. In our lessons with Emily, we have started looking at practical skills we identified as needing to strengthen. We have looked at how calendars are used and how to fill in a range of forms.
