What we have been learning this term:

Dover have become explorers this term and have really enjoyed getting to know their local area through walks.

We've been very lucky and joined Tiverton Class on adventures to collect items to use in our Woodland Area. The students have been able to sketch Donnington Castle, build dens at Snelsmore and get very muddy throughout the woods in Hermitage. During our time in the Woodland Area, Dover have created mobile shapes to hang up, made clay faces to put on the walls and even spent time getting messy in the muddy kitchens – it's been lovely to watch them enjoy all the nature around us.
