What a busy term we have had!

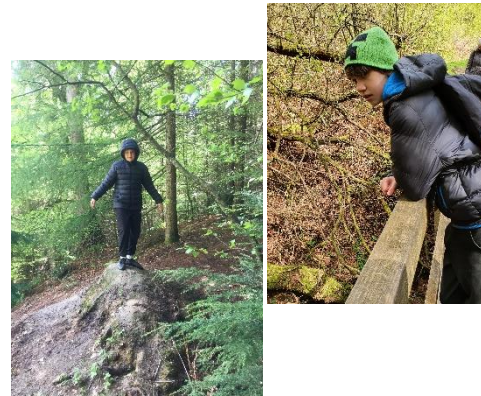
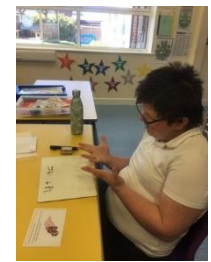
The class are reading and learning around James and the Giant Peach in English and in drama. The class are very lucky to have Becki from the Corn Exchange to come in and lead a performance.
