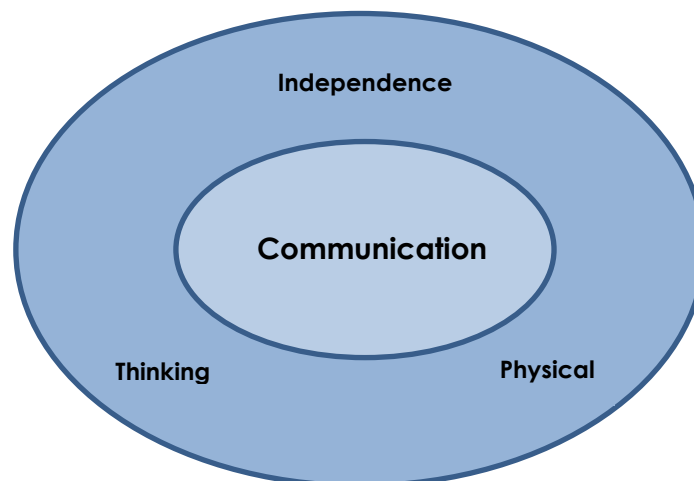




The Discover Pathway

At The Castle School we recognise that as educators we need to ensure that the pupils' needs are being met in a way that is relevant, effective and enjoyable and promotes excellent learning for all. Our most complex pupils have access to the Discover Pathway which works on the prerequisite skills for learning, taking into account the individual's current strengths and needs. It enables them to develop a sense of security in their environment and to build relationships with familiar adults around them. Through this pathway they will develop the opportunity to make an impact on their world around them through their communication, begin to gain control of their environment and enable their own independence.

We recognise that for those complex learners, Communication is the most important area and this forms the central focus for this curriculum. The pathway features these four areas, interwoven throughout all learning opportunities.



A multi-disciplinary approach is important for this pathway and pupils following this journey will often have involvement from the therapy team, school nursing team, dietician and the Sensory Consortium. Integrated therapy reviews with the Speech and Language Therapist, Physiotherapist and the Occupational Therapist working jointly with home and school will provide support and plans to build into this pathway creating a personalised roadmap linked to the EHCP.
