What's been going on in class

In Balmoral class for English we are reading the book *Carrot Soup*. Throughout the term the children have received letters from different characters asking for help on how to read instructions. The children have gradually learnt through the term that instructions use numbers to show an order and bossy verbs to tell you what to do. They have recently written their own instructions on how to make carrot soup, including pictures to give greater detail.

In Maths we have practised counting on when adding more to a number and have applied this learning when adding coin values together. More recently we've learnt how we can use weighing scales to measure which of two items is heavier, lighter or whether they are balanced. In Science we have been learning all about how plants grow and have planted our own vegetables in the polytunnel.

In topic, we have enjoyed learning about how farmers need to harvest their crops before the winter season to avoid them getting ruined by the cold weather. We have looked at colour mixing in Art and have enjoyed Friday's inclusion class with our friends from Pembroke class. Most of all we have enjoyed going to RDA for horse-riding and cooking lots of different yummy treats.
