## What we have been learning:

What a busy term Oxford Class have had! We have continued

### Science

We have been learning about our digestive systems, teeth and the effect of drinks on our teeth. We worked with Totnes to recreate the digestive system practically using plastic bags (stomach), tights (intestines) and coke (stomach acid). We were all fascinated (if not a bit repulsed) by what happens to our food in our digestive systems.

We learnt about our teeth including the names and purpose of the different types of teeth. We also set up an investigation on the effect of sugar using boiled eggs as teeth. We put the eggs into different drinks for three days and then observed what had happened. We found out that drinks with dark colours and lots of sugar has a bad effect on the eggs.

### Foodwise

We have continued to develop our cooking skills. We have baked and decorated biscuits and have worked on being able to make simple snacks, like beans on toast and a cup of tea, independently. For Diwali we made chicken curry, spicy rice and chapattis. We enjoyed tasting what we had cooked.
