**Christian:** What a fantastic reader you are, you have learnt your alphabet in order and are now using your sounds too to read, fabulous!

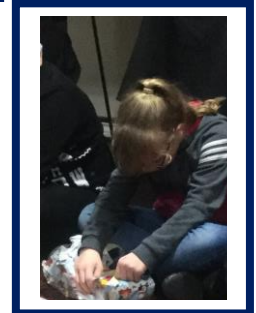
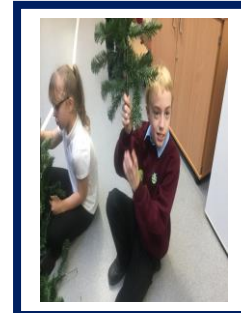
**Connor:** Every day you make sure we all know the date and timetable, thank you for helping me to keep on track. Incredible!
