Well, we have had a very busy half term here in Pendennis. To start with we continued our rainforest theme and explored non-fiction books, completing activities that were related to what we found. We also continued to warm up in the mornings to Animal Boogie. We then moved onto Christmas and engaged in a massage story and a sensory story of the First Christmas in English. We also completed sequencing and comprehension activities around the First Christmas story.

In maths we have been working on 2D and 3D shapes, building towers, following patterns, creating pictures using shape and thinking about the properties of shape. We have carried our shape work into cooking and art by making salt dough decorations using shape, baking biscuits using shapes and other crafting activities.

Cooking has been a firm favourite, where we have been developing our independence skills. Another favourite has been science. This term we have been investigating and starting to record our findings. The activities have all been very sensory such as colour mixing, melting ice, checking materials for whether they are absorbent or not and checking whether substances dissolve. Sensory activities have been a favourite in art and on a Friday afternoon too. In the picture you can see us all taking part in table art where we made patterns and shapes in paint on the table and then laid paper on top to take a print of what we had created.
