Oh my goodness this term has gone so quickly! We have all been enjoying building our relationships and working towards all our individual targets.

In English we have continued to read 'Megamonster' by David Walliams. We have sequenced pictures from the story and answered comprehension questions. We are listening to the remainder of the story and created zombifying glasses and turned ourselves into different creatures with different powers! We have also continued to focus on our individual phonics targets, learning new sounds and practising blending and segmenting our known sounds to read and write words and sentences.

In Maths we have continued to look at number, focusing on number bonds to 10 and using the part-whole model to break numbers down and create addition sentences. We have also been using the counting on method to solve addition problems. We have now begun to look at 2D shape, assessing knowledge and exploring sides and corners.

We have been fortunate to explore our local community this term with two trips – one to the cinema to watch 'Jungle Cruise' and we have also been to the Corn Exchange to watch the pantomime of Cinderella! We have also continued to go horse riding each Monday and everyone has been working towards their listening and physical goals.
