Topic: Me and my Community

What we have been doing this term:

Oxford Class have had another busy term. We have continued to focus on aspects of our local area and community.

Geography

We have explored different types of maps. We learnt about map symbols and how they represent different locations. We also learnt how to describe the position of different locations using grid-references. We used alpha-numeric and 2-digit grid references.

English

In English we have read the book 'The Great (Food) Bank Heist' about a group of children who try and catch thieves that are stealing donations for the food bank. This book allowed us to explore what it was like for some of the characters when their family didn't have enough money for food and how they might have felt in different situations.

Food Bank

Some of the class were fortunate enough to go and visit the food bank to deliver the school harvest donations. We saw how the foods were checked and sorted when they arrive at the warehouse and we had a go at checking the dates on items ourselves. We then saw how all the items were stored and packed ready into food parcels.

World Of Work

We have been having World of Work sessions with a lady called Shabana from The Department of Work and Pensions. In the sessions we have looked at skills and qualities and explored what our strengths are. We also completed an online quiz which then told us what type of skills we have and made suggestions about jobs that might suit us.

Drama

In drama, with Anna, Oxford Class have been exploring a play called 'The terrible fate of Humpty Dumpty'. The play looks at the impacts of bullying and the class have explored different characters and their roles in the different situations.
