What we have been learning this term:

Farnham Class have enjoyed the topic of 'What's on your plate?' this term. We've researched recipes from the Caribbean which has allowed us to try coconut dumplings, tropical smoothies and a Caribbean macaroni and cheese with our own twist. We've used the topic of food in our English to support our reading. We have been working on our reading comprehension and phonics, enjoying stories together and discussing these as a group.
