Topic: What's on your plate?

What we have been learning this term:

This term we started our new topic "what's on your plate?". In English we have been looking at a non-fiction book about fruit. The book shows pictures of the outside of the fruit and then the inside of the fruit. We have explored the real fruit by: looking, smelling, touching, licking, biting and eating it. Each child has explored the fruit in their own way and all have made progress in tolerating new foods, trying new foods or eating new foods. Which has made the whole team very proud. Along with trying the fruit, the pupils have been learning the symbols and words for the fruit. One pupil has been writing the fruit names and learning how to spell them. By the end of the term we will have looked at the same type of book about vegetables, explored the vegetables and learnt the symbols and words.

In maths our group topic has been position words, and the pupils have been completing activities that require them to listen to the position word the adult says. In their individual work we have continued working on our understanding of number.

Art and cooking have supported our English work looking at fruits and vegetables. In Art the pupils have: used the English book to find the correct colour to colour/paint pictures, cut out pictures of fruit and vegetables to collage on a photo of themselves so they have funky hair and used fruit and vegetables to print patterns. Cooking has been all about knife skills and exploring the foods by making fruit and vegetable: kebabs, faces and hedgehogs.

In life lessons our focus has been on road safety. The pupils have experienced stop and go games, been expected to respond to stop and go and are learning to respond to stop and go in relation to the colours of traffic lights.
