In **maths**, Tiverton have been working on the topic of money. We have been learning how to pay for a range of items, as well as how to accept and check change. We have also been on trips out to Costa and Tesco where we have applied our knowledge of money to real life, practical situations.

In **English**, we have been working on improving our writing skills, with a specific focus on punctuation, spelling and grammar. Pupils applied these skills through money-themed writing tasks, including imagining what they would do if they won £1 million.

In **science**, we have carried out many fun experiments, including the penny cleaning experiment, the fizzy lemon experiment and the Coke and Mentos experiment. Pupils have really enjoyed observing the different chemical reactions taking place.

In **World of Work (WoW)**, we have been exploring a range of industries to help us identify areas of potential interest. We have learned about roles within construction, retail, healthcare, hospitality and education.

In **geography**, we have been learning about global and fair trade. We have also explored where our fruit and vegetables come from and have been looking out for the fair-trade symbol during our weekly shopping trips.

In **PSHE**, we have been learning about how to look after our mental health and emotional wellbeing. We have explored a range of emotions and coping strategies, as well as identifying who we can talk to if we are struggling with our emotions.

We have also enjoyed many **off-site visits** this term. We took a train to Reading and had a guided tour of the station, visited Costa, went to the Thames Valley Police Museum and enjoyed our weekly shopping trips.
