Topic: Hi Ho, Hi Ho! It's Off to Work We Go.

What we have been doing this term:

We have had a wonderful term in York Class exploring our topic, "Hi Ho, Hi Ho! It's Off to Work We Go." In **English**, we have been learning about different jobs people do. The children have enjoyed listening to short stories, reviewing the books, answering questions, and using Colourful Semantics to write short captions. We have also been exploring role play and toys that link to the stories.

In Phonics, we continued working on Phase 2, revisiting familiar sounds and learning some new ones too.

In **Maths**, our focus has been money. We have practised recognising coins, finding named coins, counting coins, and selecting a given amount. The children have really enjoyed applying this learning in our weekly class snack shop.

In PSHE, we explored the Zones of Regulation, thinking about how our bodies might feel when we experience different emotions.

Across the wider curriculum, we have continued developing our turn-taking, communication and engagement skills.

This term, we also began our off-site trips to the shops. The children have been working hard on accessing our local community safely and building their independence.
