Topic: Cards, cash and contributions

What we have been doing this term:

Oxford Class have another busy term. We have started a new topic about 'Cards, cash and contributions' looking at a range of topics linked to money and budgeting.

History

In history, we have learnt about the history of money and shopping and how both have changed over time. We learnt about Roman coins and how 'hoards' have been found by metal detectorists. We had a go at using a metal detector to find coins hidden in soil. We also designed our own Roman coins including features such as portraits of an emperor and the 'legend' (the inscription around the edge of the coin).

Science

In Science, we have explored magnets and investigated what materials are attracted to magnets and which magnets were the strongest by finding out how many paperclips different magnets could hold. We have also created electrical circuits to make a light bulb light or a buzzer.

English

In English we have been learning about newspapers and news reports. We have investigated the features of a news report and explored real and fake news stories and images. We have also attempted to write our own news report.

Maths

In Maths, we have been learning about time, perimeter and areas. We have been showing times on analogue and digital times and solved problems adding on times.

We have been learning how to work out the perimeter and area of shapes.
