What we have been learning

Our topic this term has been Old MacDonald had a Farm. We used the book Oh Dear by Rod Campbell to support our learning.

In English the children have been focusing on matching and labelling skills to support our reading. We've also been having a go at making marks using different tools and techniques – we used feathers to make marks in sand and even drove tractors through muddy paint to make long lines. The children particularly enjoyed making muddy animal footprints!

In Maths we have continued to practice our counting, with a focus on 1:1 correspondence.

As part of our topic work, we listened to animal sounds and matched them to the animals as well as matching farm animals to their homes and baby animals to their mummies.

We have also continued to work on our transitions around the school, enjoying weekly trips to Soft Play and the Library. The children are doing really well and we're so proud of them all!
