This half term we have been busy learning about all things 'Pop Culture'. We have looked at how pop culture developed after WW2 and how it has changed over time and why. We have looked at technology, music, art, films, famous people and created a class playlist of our favourite songs. We have researched about an individual area of pop culture to find out when it was popular and if it is still popular today. We have also made a pop art self-portrait with areas of pop culture that we think represent us. In cooking we have made some of our best recipes yet!
