What we have been doing this term:

In English, students have taken part in the *BookTrust* project, reviewing children's books and creating work that will be displayed in the library over Easter.

Maths has focused on money, with students enjoying role-play shops and learning about budgets and real-life spending.


In PSHE, the class explored weekly themes through the Waves of Wellbeing programme, supporting emotional understanding and relationships.

In Life Skills, students investigated different types of weather, created rain gauges and filmed an exciting Newsround-style weather report, choosing to present either outdoors or using the green screen.

In The World We Live In, learning included Chinese New Year, the Big Garden Bird Watch, a virtual bird watch, and Burns Night, where students made paper kilts.

Community visits supported this learning, including trips to Thatcham Lakes for bird watching, the garden centre to explore seeds for summer, and regular library visits linked to the *BookTrust* project.
