What's been going on

Dover Class have continued to enjoy our topic, 'What's on your plate?'

English

This half term, we have looked at a range of food themed non-fiction texts. Using iPads, we have created our own presentations to explain each step of the food production cycle for milk, cheese, honey and sausages. We have been very impressed with students' sentence writing.

Maths

We have continued to look at addition problems and have been estimating lengths of everyday objects using non-standard units of measurement.

Ukraine Fundraising

Dover have been learning about the Ukraine conflict presently happening. From these lessons students agreed that they wanted to help by raising some money. Through project lessons with Tiverton Class, led by the students' ideas, we organised a cake sale and fun games at an outdoor fayre. In addition to this, students made bacon and veggie butties to sell to staff for £3. During both these events, students worked in groups and were responsible for completing certain jobs. Science

We have learned about our skeleton and organs. Students have built a skeleton and used augmented reality to take a closer look at their insides. They have learnt about the role of the skeleton and the very important jobs their organs do!

Topic

Students received a visit from Jan from Newbury & District Agricultural Society. They took part in three workshops and learned about cows, goats and pigs. Students learned about the milk pasteurisation process and sampled goat cheese. They also learned about the different parts of the pig and took part in a sausage making workshop!
