What we have been doing

Dunnottar class have worked hard to complete units and objectives for this term.

We have now finished our Diversity topic and students had a 'quiz-off' to apply all of their knowledge learnt and developed around Martin Luther King.

World of Work sessions have continued to explore Customer Service and students have engaged in role play to develop key communication skills and application of language. This has then been further supported by communication intervention where students engage in team activities to develop team work skills.

The array of activities taking place on a Tuesday result in students developing life skills during cooking and whilst at the Farm and Horse Riding. Wellbeing has focussed on elements of stress and how we can cope with the feelings these evoke within ourselves. Students have explored scenarios and case studies and discussed these. We are now in the process of applying these situations to ourselves.

Functional Skill lessons have continued to explore concepts associated with real life as well as benefit students in their future plans. Students have sat practise papers to inform the real examinations in June. Maths has focussed on money and English has focussed on informative writing.

Drama sessions have continued to focus on the play DNA. Students have worked in script writing as well as role play of specific scenes. This has been linked to other areas of the curriculum such as PSHE.

Experience Afternoon has continued to allow for students to develop new skills and exposure to a range of curriculum opportunities. Students have also continued to explore P.E. with a range of different activities to encourage physicality. Swimming has further supported this and shopping has encouraged access to the community and application of key life skills.
