



What we have been doing this term:

In English, students completed their work for the *BookTrust* project and visited the library to hand in their final pieces, which we hope will be displayed over the Easter holidays. The class also created read-aloud story videos for primary students to celebrate World Book Day, carefully choosing books they thought younger students would enjoy. To finish the term, students wrote their own Easter stories and created short story books.

In Maths, the class explored 2D and 3D shapes through practical activities including shape bingo, scavenger hunts and creating Easter animals using shapes. Students also revisited repeating patterns by designing patterned Easter eggs.

In PSHE, students finished their work on the *Waves of Wellbeing* programme, exploring sea creatures and their stories linked to different emotions, helping to develop understanding of feelings and wellbeing.

A highlight of our community trips was visiting town to exchange World Book Day tokens for books, as well as a trip to the cinema as part of the *Into Film Festival*, where students enjoyed watching *Paddington in Peru* at the Corn Exchange.

In PE, the class has been developing their badminton skills.

In *The World We Live In*, students explored a range of springtime celebrations including Mother's Day, St Patrick's Day and Ramadan, we have enjoyed exploring of different cultures and traditions.
