What we have been learning this term:

Whittington class have enjoyed another great (but short) term.

In English we have been writing reports about environmental issues such as climate change and global warming, explaining the impact upon endangered species of animals and deforestation.

During Maths lessons, students have been measuring length, mass, capacity and weight and revised time, days and months of the year.

Our science topic this term is electricity and building working circuits.

In Personal Growth and Wellbeing lessons students have been completing their assignments reflecting on ways to maintain our emotional wellbeing and possible issues which might affect our quality of life.

Those studying Land Based Studies have started a new unit of work about growing plants. We are very privileged to work alongside staff at Earth Trust to plan and plant their new market garden. There are 80 beds to plant and harvest growing food to sell in their new cafe.

During DT lessons, students have been preparing the garden ready for spring planting and are looking forward to the summer term.

In Home Cooking Skills students are learning about food provenance considering food mileage; they learned that it is not possible to be self-sufficient due to climate and economic issues. We made cottage pie, toad in the hole and prepared some Easter inspired treats.

We regularly take nature walks, whatever the weather, and some go climbing where they have worked as a team belaying and supporting each other.


