In English, we have been writing about our experiences and trips into the community. We use switches, communication aids, Makaton, gesture, and our voices, to communicate. We visited Newbury Library to talk to the librarian, and listen to one of the special stories. We listened to the books, as sensory stories, and made some fab crafts, for a display at Newbury Library. We enjoyed exploring books for World Book Day, especially One Big Family, (one of the World Book Day stories. We had a Peppa Pig picnic and made some snacks. We visited Waterstones and TD Jones to buy our books with our World Book Day Vouchers.

In PSHE, we have been thinking about public and private places and body parts.

It has been great to continue to explore different environments in school, including the soft play and the library.

Windsor have continued to work on the Agricultural Challenge this year. We will take our work to the final in June, at Arlington arts, and will showcase our work, alongside special schools from across Berkshire. We have finished our collage based on the story Oliver's Vegetables.
