## What we have been learning this term:

Whittington class embraced the start of the summer term with lots of enthusiasm.

In English we have been reading, writing and talking about our local community. Students have been challenged to role play and ask questions to access local facilities and activities as well as practising for future assessments coming up.

During Maths lessons they have focussed on how data is represented using graphs and charts.

In science this term students have been learning about Ohms Law and resistance in wires, calculating resistance using the current and voltage.

In Personal Growth and Well-being, we have focused on Social Health, discussing and appreciating the different relationships we experience, whether they are healthy and challenging stereotypes. We have included relationships online with this and looked at being safe and cyber security.

Those studying Land Based Studies have continued to learn about growing plants. We are beginning to see the fruits of our labours at Earth Trust in the edible garden and putting our learning into practise by propagating herbs and veg to sell using cuttings and growing from seed.

During DT lessons students have been working with plaster, pouring it to make mosaics and creating their own artwork with mixed media and mosaic patterns.

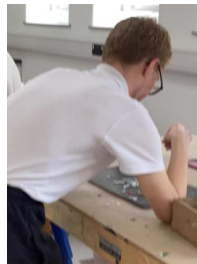
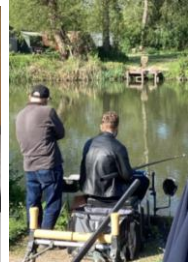
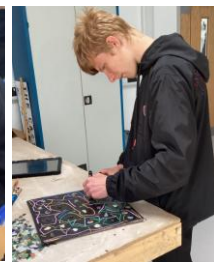
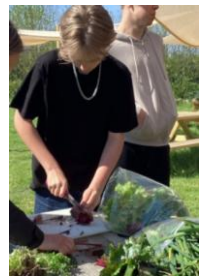
In Home Cooking we have been learning about budgeting and the cost of food especially looking at how current economic issues affect the cost of living; students have prepared a selection of healthy dishes.
