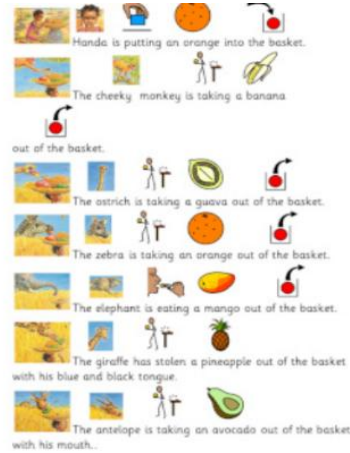
Each week the children have been fascinated by the different bucket sessions and each one has had a link to our country and this has really encouraged the children to explore the features of each country.
