Topic: My Future Self

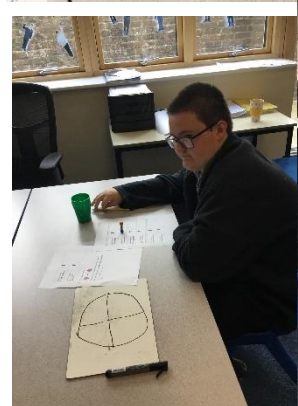
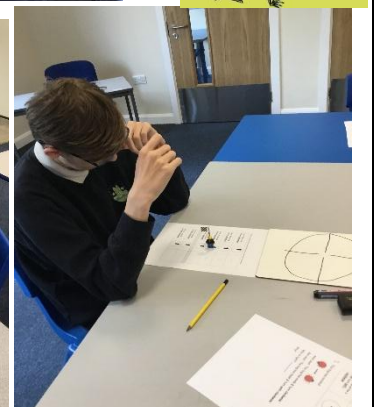
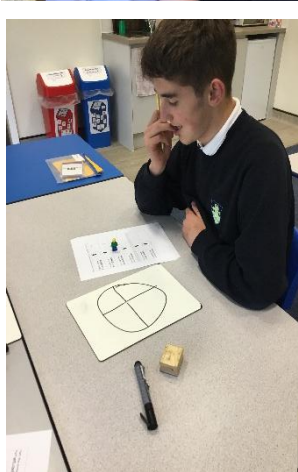
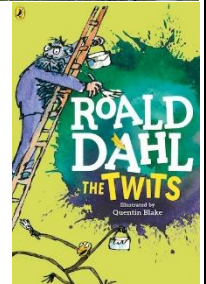
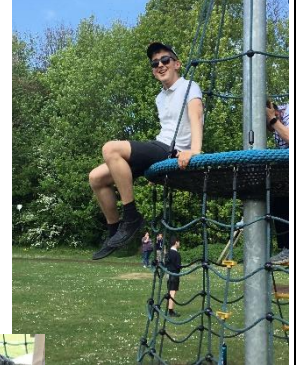
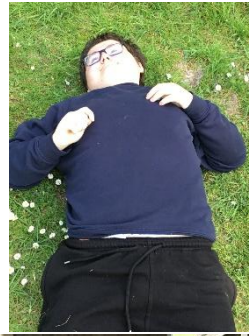
The topic this term has been My Future Self and we have used our topic lessons to explore themes around this. As a class, we have made predictions for the future and how robots may have a role in our homes. We looked at old episodes of Tomorrow's World and the class found it interesting to see how some predictions for 2020s were scarily accurate and some were very far out there.

In Maths, the students have continued to develop their understanding around number and worked on multiplication and division. The class identified the difference between the two operations and looked at the importance of understanding this in the real world – not just in a classroom! This week, we have explored rotations and turning different directions. With the help of lego mini figures, the students enjoyed physically turning something in a clockwise or anti – clockwise direction.

In English this term, we looked at Roald Dahl and specifically studied his well-known story "The Twits". The class were very engaged with the story and loved the comedic and descriptive style. They adapted chapters from the story and then thought about what they would be like if they were older or found themselves in that same situation.

The beginning of the term we were fortunate to have some lovely weather and took this as an opportunity to go to the park and get out in nature. As the year has progressed, it is fantastic to see the class feel more comfortable when out in the community and the positive impact nature has for the young people.
