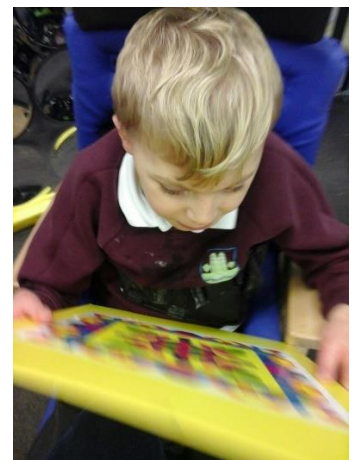
Otis has done exceptionally well settling back into school, especially with intensive interaction and tactile exploration. It's so lovely to have him back.
