Seasonal stuff!

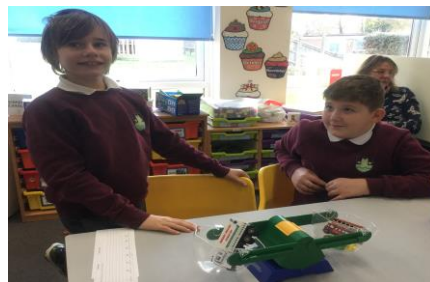
