Photography Talent!

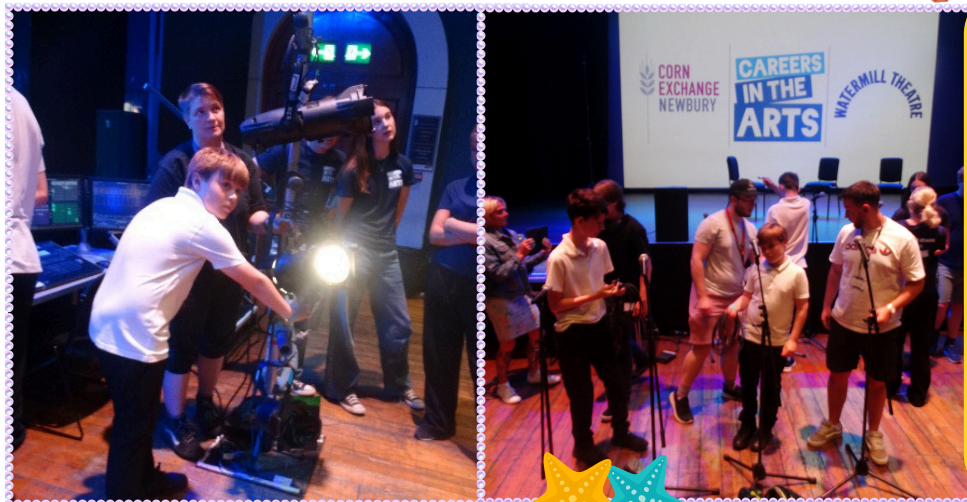
