Home School Agreement

The family will:

- Ensure that their child goes to school regularly, ready on time and properly equipped
- inform the school before 9.30 a.m. on a daily basis, the reason for any absence
- inform transport of any approved changes to daily arrangements
- inform school of any approved out of school arrangements, i.e. visiting respite carer/child minder
- let the School know about any circumstances that might affect their child's work or behaviour
- attend parents' meetings and discussions about their child's progress
- support the school's policies, guidelines for behaviour and acknowledge professional recommendations
- support their child in opportunities for home-learning
- get to know about their child's life at the school
- ensure that their child wears the school uniform and appropriate footwear
- ensure that all items of clothing and personal belongings are clearly named

The school will:

- encourage all pupils to do their best at all times
- care for the safety and well being of all pupils
- encourage all pupils to take care of their surroundings
- encourage all pupils to value one another, to respect all others and their belongings
- contact the family if there is a problem with attendance
- contact the family about any circumstances that may affect the pupil's work, behaviour or well-being
- provide a balanced curriculum to meet the individual needs of the pupils
- be open and welcoming and offer opportunities for the family to become involved in the daily life of the school
- arrange Parents' Meetings to inform the family of pupils progress
- keep family informed about School activities through regular contact
- attend school regularly
- be polite and helpful to others

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- take good care of the equipment and buildings
- wear the school uniform, suitable footwear and be tidy in appearance
